Necessary Materials:

Most of the below you can find in the house / at the Dollar store

- Leftover Latex water soluble house paint (light in color; e.g: Yellow, pink, green etc.)
- Water base urethane – glossy (Home Hardware)
- Jars / tubes of acrylic paint (If you have it)
- Paint roller and tray
- Glue gun / glue sticks (for hemming)
- Ruler and yardstick (for hemming)
- Various sizes of paint brushes (large house paint to artists brushes)
- Aluminum pie plates
- Disposables plastic containers with lids
- 3 - 5 empty squeeze bottles
- 1 empty spray bottle
- 1 roll paper towel
- 1 roll Saran wrap
- Colored pencils / lead pencil
- Sponges (domestic and cosmetic)
- Smaller roller brushes and tray
- 3 rolls of masking tape (different widths)
- Scissors
- Xacto knife
- 1 note pad or journal (Most of us need to keep a record of info, ideas, sketching etc.)
- Tissue paper
- Plastic spoons / wooden stir sticks
- Cheese cloth
- String / feathers / toothbrush / stencils / saran wrap
- Texture tools (just look around the house and think creatively!)
- Large bottle for water (For drinking... you get thirsty!)
- 2 Margarine container Lg. and sm. with lids
- Apron
- Rubber gloves / disposable gloves
- Old comfortable clothing / painting shirt
